Preeta explained to the members on our first BPC project viz.



Each team had to build a tallest tower of the newspapers given to them.







August 2022 Plastic Waste Management By Dr. Medha Tatpadrikar



On Sunday, 14th August 2022 we had an interesting session on Plastic Waste Management by Dr. Medha Tatpadrikar, a Plastic Warrior, TEDx Speaker, Writer and Entrepreneur.

Dr. Medha is a Member of National Plastic Committee of Material Recovery Association of India and Managing Committee Member on Plastic, MSME Chamber of Commerce & Industry of India and Founding Trustee of Keshav Sita Memorial Foundation Trust.

She explained to the members how this Trust is instrumental in creating awareness of waste plastic and segregation at source for better waste management. This Trust collects waste plastic from more than 35,000 households, hotels and offices in and around Pune, managed to connect and inculcate habit of source segregation amongst more than 1.5lakh people. The Trust has also been collecting waste plastic from far away places like Baramati, Baneshwar, Raigad Fort, Bhima Shankar, Thane and Dombivli. Her efforts have helped collection of more than 2,50,000 Kg of waste plastic which was otherwise headed for landfill.

Dr. Medha and her team built the first pilot machine in 2010 which converts waste plastic in to usable fuel. Currently running 3 plants in Jejuri, Pune Municipal Corporation and Kalyan Dombivli Municipal Corporation.

She urged the members to be part of their campaign "My Garbage, My Responsibility" and to segregate waste plastic at our homes and housing societies and connect with their team to collect it.



We had another interesting session on Sunday, 18th September '22 by Ms. Ojaswini Sapatnekar.


Ms. Sapatnekar is a HR Professional with over 15 years of experience with eminent corporates viz. Convergys India Pvt. Ltd., Nihilent Technologies Pvt. Ltd., Thermax Ltd., Bekaert Industries Pvt. Ltd and Upcurve Business Services.

She is presently Vice President-Human Resource of "udChalo". She comes from an army family. Throughout her life she saw her father fighting for the country and keep the civilians safe. Her Father being her role model, she too developed a wish to serve the country but due to circumstances she could not achieve her dreams. But she always hoped to fulfill that wish and be around her "Family". After 12 years of working in MNCs she finally found a workplace named "udChalo", which she calls her second home.

She explained Maslow's Need Hierarchy Theory of how we move on from Physiological needs, Safety Needs, Love and belonging, Esteem and Self Actualization. How mankind transitioned from 1st Revolution (Mechanization, steam and water power in 1780)to 2nd Revolution (Mass production and Electricity in 1870) to 3rd Revolution (Electronics and IT systems, automation in 1970) to 4th Revolution (Cyber Physical systems in 2000)

- 3) udChalo Service for services (Challenges of Defence personnel)




