Dear Members,


"Every project is an opportunity to learn, to figure out problems and challenges, to invent and reinvent." <u>David Rockwell</u>


Sometimes, it's not how long we live but how we live it. Be a channel of joy and blessing to others.

Come **APRIL** and its time for the Administrative Professionals Week, a much-awaited time of the year!







On Sunday, 14th May 2023 we had an interesting and mindful session by Ms. Anupama Pradhan, Life Coach/Trainer/Educator/Speaker/Founder - Inner Shift

Humans have the wonderful ability to adapt and change. As such, we have the capability to create excellence in the life we choose. We wonder how some people manage to create that excellence whilst others just go with the flow. Anupama made us aware how NLP - Neuro Linguistic Programming, helps us to create that excellence.

Neuro - How we think

Linguistic - Language and non-verbal communication

Anupama shared an example of a lady who was shy, timid and emotionally weak initially, later on became a bold, strong woman who could speak up for herself and her children due to techniques of NLP.


She also shared her own example of she could alter the relationship with her eldest son from a disturbed to a loving one by using this powerful mind technique.


Oath taking ceremony was conducted by the elected Managing Committee Team.



She is working with Art of Living and oversees Information Centre for Pimpri Chinchwad area.


She loves to eat pani-puri, chatting with people, cooking new veg dishes.

"Years ago, anthropologist Margaret Mead was asked by a student what she considered to be the first sign of civilization in a culture. The student expected Mead to talk about fishhooks or clay pots or grinding stones.


But no. Mead said that the first sign of civilization in an ancient culture was a femur (thighbone) that had been broken and then healed. Mead explained that in the animal kingdom, if you break your leg, you die. You cannot run from danger, get to the river for a drink or hunt for food. You are meat for prowling beasts. No animal survives a broken leg long enough for the bone to heal.


