Although time seems to fly, it never travels faster than one day at a time, so enjoy each day as it comes with love, joy and gratitude.


Failures, mistakes, rejection. They need to exist so that they can push us to the next level. So don't hate them, thank them.



Assunta Christy introduced Dnyaneshwari and Preeta Venugopal introduced Sakshi to our members.


Members got to interact with both of them on one-on-one basis. Both the girls were nervous as well as happy and excited to greet and meet so many ladies at a time.

The members of Snehalaya Institute were managing the stall put up them. Varieties of candles, handmade greeting cards, jewelry, purses and woolen items were displayed.


Members patronized both these stalls as they had good gifting options for Diwali festival.





The interaction with children and the care takers was a humbling experience. I am sure members went back home with satisfaction of time well spent.



Oh what a wonderful and joyful evening, an evening we will never forget!





Khichdi Map of India: Sisters Share 60 Fusion Recipes of This Soul-Satisfying Dish

Ratika Bhargava and Riccha Khetan, founders of the Cauldron Sisters, have published a book of khichdi recipes from across the country. Here's a map of the much-loved dish in it's different forms.

Curled up with a warm bowl of rice with lentils seasoned with spices encapsulates the essence of India's most loved dish - *khichdi*. Though the pages of the country's culinary history have been splattered with variations of the dish, they bear traces of feelings of nostalgia and comfort that the dish evokes as soon as the first spoon coats your palate.

Khichdi boasts of being <u>one of the oldest dishes</u> to be cooked in the country, as history says even French traveler Jean-Baptiste Tavernier remarked on his trips to India in the 1600s that this 'peasant's evening meal' prepared with green lentils, rice and *ghee* was very common in the subcontinent.


The name of the dish itself stems from the Sanskrit word '*khiccha*', which translates to a dish prepared with rice and legumes.

What is fascinating is that this meal has still managed to retain a prime spot on the dinner tables of today.


